

**MINIMUM IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR
SCHOOL ENTRY 2018-2019**

When a child enrolls in a school corporation for the first time, or any subsequent time and at any level, the parents must show either that the student has been immunized or that a current religious or medical objection is on file and updated at the beginning of every school year. Parents must provide the school corporation with complete immunization records prior to the beginning of the school year.

MINIMUM IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ENROLLED IN KINDERGARTEN:

- 5 doses of any combination of the following: diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (Dtap), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), diphtheria-tetanus vaccine (DT) 4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose is on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose.
- 4 doses of any combination OPV or IPV. The 4th dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose. 3 doses of all OPV or all IPV are accepted if the 3rd dose is on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 2nd dose.
- 2 doses of measles (Rubeola) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 2 doses of mumps vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine. (3rd dose must be given on or after 24 weeks of age and no earlier than 16 weeks after the 1st dose.)
- 2 doses of varicella on or after 1st birthday and separated by 3 months or physician written documentation of history of chicken pox disease, including month and year of disease.
- 2 doses of Hepatitis A vaccine 6 months apart (1st vaccine no earlier than 12 months old.) This is a requirement for students K-4, 6th, and 12th and optional for students in 5th, and 7th-11th.

**IN ADDITION, STUDENTS ENTERING 6TH GRADE ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO
HAVE:**

- 1 Tdap (Tentanus & Pertussis)
- 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal)

**LASTLY, STUDENTS ENTERING 12TH GRADE ARE REQUIRED (IN ADDITON) TO
HAVE:**

- 2nd MCV4 (Meningococcal)
