

TELL CITY JR.-SR. HIGH SCHOOL OPENING INFORMATION

Students in grades 7 through 12 who were **not** enrolled in the Tell City-Troy Township School Corporation on the last day of the 2017-2018 school year are asked to come to Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School for enrollment purposes Wednesday through Friday, July 25 - 27 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Students who attended William Tell Elementary last year do not need to enroll. Orientation for 7th graders and any students new to the corporation will be Monday, July 30 starting at 5:30 p.m. in the auditorium. Parents and their 7th graders and any students new to Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School are invited and strongly encouraged to attend the orientation session to pick up schedules, take tours, and receive important information. All students may access schedules online starting on Monday, July 30.

Students in grades 7 - 9 who have questions or who would like to request a schedule change may do so by emailing counselor Cindia Ress at cindia.ress@tellcity.k12.in.us. Students in grades 10 - 12 should email counselor Lisa Noble at lisa.noble@tellcity.k12.in.us. Should students and parents prefer to come to the office instead of emailing please do so between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday and Tuesday, July 30 and 31. The office will be closed on Wednesday, August 1 due to staff meetings.

The amount of textbook rental and fees may vary greatly and will depend upon the individual student's schedule. **Because of the number of schedule changes at the JSHS level, book rental at the junior-senior high school will not be established and payable until Monday, August 13.** At that time, book rental may be paid online with a credit or debit card through your child's Harmony account, by a mailed check, or by check or cash in person. Any necessary schedule changes should be made before paying book rental.

Parents and students should park in the staff/visitors' parking lot off Fulton Street. Should students choose to pick up schedules in person, please note that shirts and shoes are required when entering the building.

School will begin for students at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 2 with all students in grades 9 - 12 reporting to homerooms and 7th and 8th graders meeting in the Bryan Taylor Sports Arena at the 7:55 bell.
