To: Parents & Guardians of all Pre-K, 5th, and 11th grade students

This letter is to inform you that your child is due for vaccines. The Indiana State Department of Health **REQUIRES** all Indiana students to be vaccinated **BEFORE** the first day of kindergarten, 6th, or 12th grade.

We, along with Perry County Memorial Hospital and Clinics, and all Perry County Schools, are working together to inform families about these required immunizations for the upcoming school year. We encourage everyone to talk to their child's healthcare provider about these vaccines **before** the start of the 2022/2023 school year. 3. Dr. Seth Coynor at the 13th Street Clinic
 - 812-547-9661. These are offered to non-insured, under-insured, Medicaid, and privately insured patients by appointment only.
4. Perry County Health Department
 - 812-547-2746. These are offered to non-insured, under-insured, Medicaid, and privately insured patients by appointment only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
