

TELL CITY JR.-SR. HIGH SCHOOL OPENING INFORMATION

Students in grades 7 through 12 who were **not** enrolled in the Tell City-Troy Township School Corporation on the last day of the 2019-20 school year are asked to contact Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School at 812-547-3131 for enrollment purposes Wednesday through Friday, July 29 - 31 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Students who attended William Tell Elementary last year do not need to enroll. Orientation for 7th graders and any students new to the corporation will be Wednesday, July 29 starting at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom. Parents and their 7th graders and any students new to Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School are strongly encouraged to view the orientation session to receive important information. All students may access schedules online starting on Thursday, July 30. Students in grades 7 - 9 who have questions or who would like to request a schedule change may do so by emailing counselor Cindia Ress at cindia.ress@tellcity.k12.in.us. Students in grades 10 - 12 should email counselor Lisa Noble at lisa.noble@tellcity.k12.in.us. On-line registration begins when Harmony Family Access opens up on July 30. The amount of textbook rental and fees may vary greatly and will depend upon the individual student's schedule. Because of the number of schedule changes at the JSHS level, book rental at the junior-senior high school will not be established and payable until approximately one week after school begins. **Please do not pay book rental until you receive an invoice which will be sent via email approximately two weeks after school starts.** At that time, book rental may be paid online with a credit or debit card through your child's Harmony account, by a mailed check, or by check or cash in person. Any necessary schedule changes should be made before paying book rental.

School will begin for students at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 4 with all students reporting to homerooms at the 7:45 bell.
