

TELL CITY JR.-SR. HIGH SCHOOL OPENING INFORMATION

Students in grades 7 through 12 who were **not** enrolled in the Tell City-Troy Township School Corporation on the last day of the 2020-2021 school year are asked to come to or contact Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School at 812-547-3131 for enrollment purposes Wednesday through Friday, July 28 - 30 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Students who attended William Tell Elementary last year do not need to enroll. Orientation for 7th graders and any students new to the corporation will be Wednesday, July 28 starting at 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium. Parents and their 7th graders and any students new to Tell City Jr.-Sr. High School are strongly encouraged to attend the orientation session to receive important information.

Parents are able to start completing the new school year paperwork in Harmony when Harmony Family Access opens up at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 28. Parents who want to complete paper copies instead of submitting them online should email Jennifer Hall at jennifer.hall@tellcity.k12.in.us or call the office at 812-547-3131. Also on July 28 starting at 4:00, students may access schedules. Any students with questions or who would like to request a schedule change may do so by emailing counselor Lisa Noble at lisa.noble@tellcity.k12.in.us.

Parents are reminded that the State of Indiana is requiring two items with proof of residency beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. Documentation may include such items as a current utility bill, telephone bill, tax return, bank statement, mortgage statement, rental/lease agreement, medical bill or other similar information that provides a verifiable address. Documentation should be dated within 60 days of student enrollment and the date should be clearly identified and readable on the copy on file for the student.

The amount of textbook rental and fees may vary greatly and will depend upon the individual student's schedule. Because of the number of schedule changes at the JSHS level, book rental at the junior-senior high school will not be established and payable until approximately one week after school begins. **Please do not pay book rental until you receive an invoice which will be sent via email approximately two weeks after school starts.** At that time, book rental may be paid online with a credit or debit card through your child's Harmony account, by a mailed check, or by check or cash in person. **Any necessary schedule changes should be made before paying book rental.**

School will begin for students at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 3. Students should arrive at school no earlier than 7:30 a.m. and, upon arrival, report to either the Bryan Taylor Sports Arena or the cafeteria. At the 7:55 a.m. bell, students in grades 7 and 8 should go to the BTSA where they will begin their day and high school students should report to homerooms.
